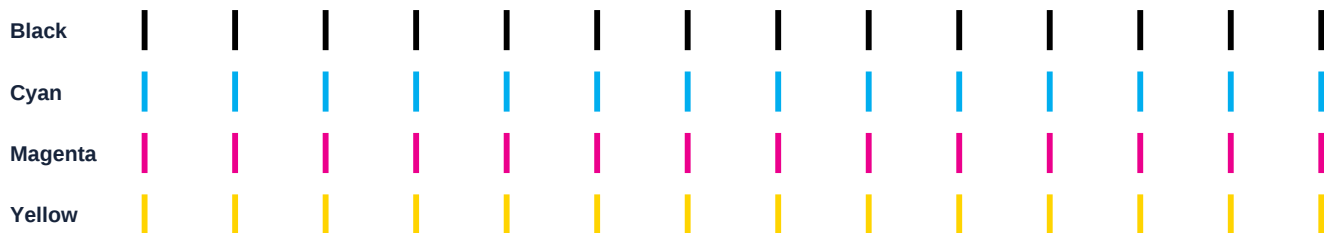


Printer Alignment & Nozzle-Check Test Page

Print this page at 100% scale (no "fit to page" or scaling) and compare it against the patterns below.

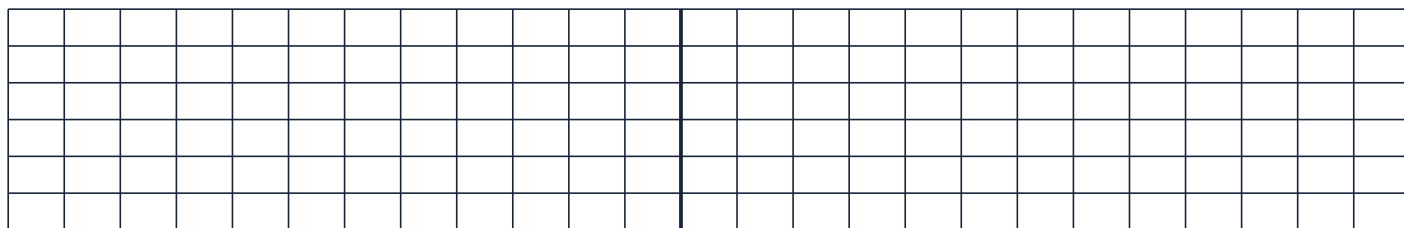
1. Nozzle check — look for gaps or missing lines

Each band should be a solid, unbroken set of lines. A gap means that color nozzle needs cleaning.



2. Alignment grid — lines should be straight and evenly spaced

Wavy, doubled, or unevenly spaced lines indicate a head-alignment issue.



3. Grayscale gradient — steps should be distinct, not banded



4. Color swatches — check for accurate, even color



5. Text clarity — check sharpness at small sizes
